This Letter of Intent (LoI) is made between Institute of Marine Biotechnology, Universiti Malaysia Terengganu, MALAYSIA (hereafter referred to as "IMB-UMT") and Faculty of Science and Mathematics, Diponegoro University, INDONESIA (hereafter referred to as "FSM-UNDIP").

TERMS OF COOPERATION

1. IMB-UMT and FSM-UNDIP express their intention to develop cooperation in research and education.
2. The aims of the LoI are to improve the competence of academic staffs and graduates, and to increase international collaboration in research and education.
3. IMB-UMT and FSM-UNDIP agree to promote and develop cooperation through the following activities:

A. Joint Research Program for Academic Staff Members

The topics of research activities may include research related to Basic Chemistry, Organic Chemistry, Inorganic Chemistry, Physical Chemistry, Analytical Chemistry, Marine Biotechnology, which may involve interdisciplinary approaches, including Biology, Nanoscience, Nanotechnology and Nanotoxicology, Biotechnology, Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, Applied Informatics and Technology, Mathematical Models, Applied Ecology, Environmental Science and Sustainability, Statistics for Food Security and Sustainable Agriculture, Sustainability, Marine Biology, Aquaculture and Agriculture. In accordance with the intellectual and other property right issues, a material transfer agreement (MTA) will be applicable and the general rules of MTA will be explained separately.

B. Joint Publication, Seminar and Workshop

Every scientific result of joint research that may be presented in an international seminar, promotion of relevant joint conference, workshop or published in an international journal has to be approved by the Scientific Supervisor from both faculties.

C. Academic Staff and Student Exchanges

In the frame work of cooperation, academic staff and students shall be involved in the exchange program, by visiting the location of both faculties to contribute to formal education. The academic staff may also be included in a visiting lecture program. For the students, the regulation of credit transfer agreement (CTA) will be applicable and the general rules of the CTA will be explained separately.

D. Academic Activity

To establish programs that will enable interested and qualified students and university personnel to pursue either short-term or extended programs of study in each other's institutions as a double degree or joint degree program and to conduct collaborative joint research and publication.

GOVERNING PRINCIPLE

1. The researchers from both institution may give proposal on any activities to be carried out under the letter of intent as provided herein. Such proposals will be reviewed and deliberated in joint meetings chaired by any one of the coordinator.
2. Approval of any activities will be dependent upon the availability of funds.
3. Progress of activities will be reviewed and monitored by the coordinator.
4. In order to assess the effectiveness of the activities under the Lol, the cooperation will be monitored and evaluated each year during the time period of the Lol.
5. This Lol does not limit the right of either institution to enter into any similar agreement of cooperation with other institutions.
6. This Lol will remain in force for the period of 5 (five) years, unless either party exercises their right to terminate it by giving written notice of their intention to do so. Such notice has to be given at least 12 (twelve) months in advance.
7. This Lol is non-binding and does not impose any legal or financial obligations or liabilities on either party.

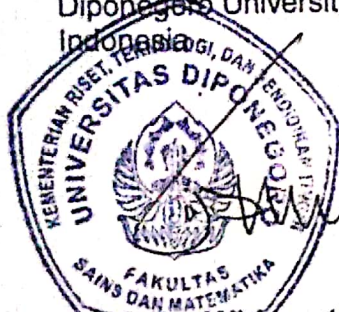
